MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This memorandum of understanding is executed at New Delhi on 31st March, 2014 between the Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences (**hereinafter referred to as the LUVAS**) having its campus at Hisar which expression shall, wherever the contents of this memorandum so permits be deemed to include its successors, legal representatives and assigns of the ONE PART

AND

Delhi Milk Scheme (**hereinafter referred to as the DMS**) having its milk processing unit at West Patel Nagar, New Delhi which expression shall, whenever the contents of this memorandum so permits be deemed to include its successors, legal representatives and assigns of the SECOND PART.

WHEREAS, the LUVAS has been set up by the Govt. of Haryana under Act No. 7 of 2010 to give a boost to the development of the Animal Husbandry Sector in the state.

AND WHEREAS the DMS is a well known organization in the field of milk processing having professional manpower to assist the LUVAS for training of the students.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties in consideration of the mutual benefits and desirous of entering into a partnership, do hereby enter into a MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (**herein after referred to as the MOU**) in accordance with the terms of agreement set out in this MOU.

THE LUVAS AND THE DMS HEREBY CONVENANT WITH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS FOLLOWS:


1. The LUVAS shall recognize the DMS as a training partner.
2. The DMS shall provide such technical help to the university on all aspects of skill development in the area of milk processing.
3. The LUVAS and DMS shall prepare any training schedule, background paper or any note on any aspect of the milk processing that might be required by the LUVAS at any time.
4. The LUVAS and DMS shall design and organize specialized training and other human resource capacity building programmes upon a request to that effect by the LUVAS.

5. The DMS may also suggest changes in curriculum / programmes on its own initiative, whether requested by LUVAS or otherwise, that in its opinion are beneficial for the skill development in the area of milk processing and enable the LUVAS to meet its objectives particularly for the Degree / Diploma in Dairy Technology.
6. The DMS shall not publically disclose any information/data that is generated or collected under any activity undertaken under any provision of this MOU without written consent of the LUVAS. Similarly it will be applicable on the part of LUVAS also in the same spirit.
7. The part of the tuition fee charged by the LUVAS as annual tuition fee from the students will be transferred to DMS by Demand Draft in favour of General Manager (DMS) in proportion as per the period for which the DMS has engaged for imparting training to the students of the LUVAS. This fee will be payable before the commencement of training at DMS.
8. During the period of training, the trainees will abide by the conduct code, rules and regulations as applicable within the premises of DMS and shall not violate the same. In the event of their violation, the DMS reserves the right to short close the training of the defaulting trainee(s).


IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:


1. Any notice required to be given by either party shall be sent by registered acknowledgement and courier, to the other parties at the addresses given in this MOU.
2. This MOU shall be valid for a period of five years from the date of signing by both the parties, and shall be extended automatically, without notice for a further period of five years each, unless desired otherwise by any of the parties.
3. That this MOU can be terminated by either party after giving one month notice sending in writing to the other party at the address given above.


