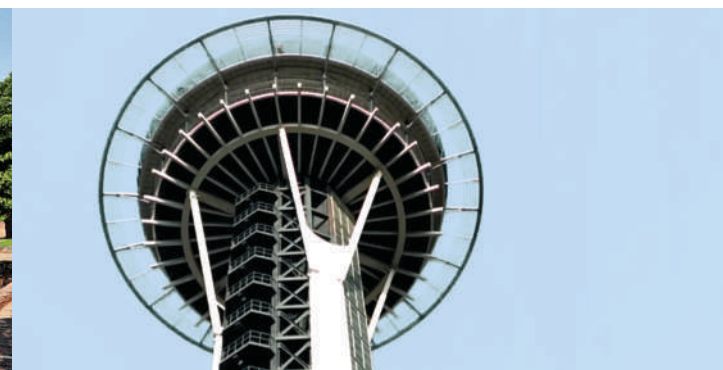

About the City

Hisar is one of the important cities of North India and is emerging as a big education hub. It has three universities and many state, central and ICAR institutes.

Hisar was founded by Emperor Firoz Shah Tughlaq in 1354 A.D. 'Hisar' is an Arabic word which means 'Fort', so it was called as Hisar Firoza or in other words the 'Fort of Firoz'. Hisar is situated 184 kms west of Delhi on the National Highway No. 9. It is well connected with rail and road routes. University campus is about 3 kms away from railway station and 4 kms away from bus stand. Buses for Hisar are available from Maharana Pratap ISBT Delhi. Nearest Airports are IGI New Delhi (186 Km) and Chandigarh (250 Km). The city has many places for visits like Ancient Gumbad, Agroha, Rakhigarhi, Baradari, Barsi Gate, Durgah Char Qutab, Feroz Shah's Palace, Gujari Mahal and Jahaj Kothi.

Accommodation

The single case reports will be considered for poster session (strictly 3' x 4' size). **The abstracts will only be accepted on registration of the delegates.**
