14.1 Preparation of the Draft thesis / Synopsis

(a) A student preparing for Master's **Or** Ph. D. degree shall submit the subject of proposed thesis and its synopsis (Form PG-3) as per Appendix IX of this Chapter) to the Dean, PGS (through Major Advisor / HOD). Major Advisor will ensure that it should be submitted to the Dean, PGS before the registration of 3rd semester of his / her admission under all circumstances failing which it will not be accepted after the stipulated period and admission shall stand cancelled. Comprehensive written examination will not be held until the synopsis is approved by the Dean, PGS.

It may be made effective from the academic session 2017-18.

Item No. 1RIC-2: Enhancement of stipend / merit stipend being offered to M.V.Sc. & Ph.D. students of LUVAS.
