Agenda Item No. 30RIC-5: Institution of Gold Medal in the name of Dr. (Capt.) Atam Parkash Galhotra for the award of Gold Medal to the best Ph.D. student in the field of Veterinary Medicine and Veterinary Public Health & Epidemiology

A request was made by Dr. (Capt.) Atam Parkash Galhotra Prof. Veterinary Preventive Medicine (Rtd.) to worthy Vice-Chancellor on 21.07.2020 to institute a Gold Medal in his name for best Ph.D. student in the discipline of Veterinary Preventive Medicine. His request was forwarded to this office on the same date. As the disciplines of Veterinary Preventive Medicine no longer exist in LUVAS so, he requested that the Gold Medal may be named as Dr. (Capt.) Atam Parkash Galhotra for Academic excellence in Ph.D. programme in the disciplines of Veterinary Medicine or Veterinary Public Health and Epidemiology. Dr. (Capt.) Atam Parkash Galhotra has been the alumnus of this college and contributed significantly in the field of Veterinary Preventive Medicine.

Accordingly, case was sent to the Dean, College of Veterinary Science to consider his request and chalk out the modalities for this award. Dean, COVS in his letter dated 13.10.2020 apprised that a joint meeting of Departmental Advisory Committee of Veterinary Medicine and Veterinary Public Health & Epidemiology after thorough deliberations, approved and recommended following guidelines for the award of Gold Medal in the name of **Dr. (Capt.) Atam Parkash Galhotra** to the best Ph. D. student amongst the students from the disciplines of Veterinary Medicine and Veterinary Public Health and Epidemiology on basis of their academic performance:

- 1) Gold Medal will be named as **“Dr. (Capt.) Atam Parkash Galhotra Gold Medal”**

- 2) The Gold Medal will be awarded **w.e.f. Academic Year 2021-2022.**
- 3) The medal will be awarded annually to the best Ph.D. student who has completed his/her degree in the disciplines of either Veterinary Medicine or Veterinary Public Health & Epidemiology. Only one Medal will be awarded to the best Ph. D. student amongst the students from the discipline of Veterinary Medicine or Veterinary Public Health and Epidemiology on the basis of academic performance.
- 4) A Committee consisting of Dean, PGS as Chairman, Dean, COVS, Director of Research, HOD Vety. Medicine and HOD VPHE, as members will scrutinize and evaluate the student's academic performance on the basis of following criteria:

Research paper published/accepted	10

Based upon Ph.D. research; two marks for each paper in journals above six NAAS rating and one mark for each paper below six NAAS rating will be awarded.

Thus, it is proposed that the Gold Medal will be named as "Dr. (Capt.) Atam Parkash Galhotra Gold Medal". For this purpose a sum of Rs/- 6 lakhs will be deposited by Dr. (Capt.) Atam Parkash Galhotra through Bank Draft in the favour of Dean, College of Veterinary Sciences, LUVAS, Hisar and medal will be awarded from the interest accrued on this principal amount. The Gold Medal will be awarded to the best Ph. D. student amongst the students from the discipline of Veterinary Medicine or Veterinary Public Health and Epidemiology on the basis of academic performance annually during the convocation. There should be minimum three applicants for the selection of best Ph. D. student on the basis of academic performance for this award. All the applicants who have completed their Ph. D. programme in the field of Veterinary Medicine or Veterinary Public Health & Epidemiology in that Academic Year will be considered for the award of Dr. (Capt.) Atam Parkash Galhotra Gold Medal.

The RIC has further recommended to place the matter before the Academic Council for kind consideration and approval, please.
