Thereafter, the following agenda items were discussed and the following decisions were taken thereof:

Agenda item No.48RIC-1: Confirmation of the proceedings of 47th meeting of the RIC held on 04.07.2022.

Agenda item No.48RIC-2: Action taken report on the proceedings of 46th meeting of RIC held on 04.07.2022.

Noted and approved.

Agenda Item No.48 RIC-3: Request of some PG students for extension in due date for thesis seminar and thesis submission.

Some PG students submitted the applications duly recommended by Major Advisors of the student and Head of the departments to the Dean, PGS office regarding the extension in due date of thesis seminar and thesis submission for the 2nd semester of Academic Year 2021-22.

Whereas, as per provision contained under Rule 14.6(C) of chapter III of University calendar Volume II which is reproduced as under:

Thesis/ dissertation shall be submitted along with proforma PG-9. The last date for submission of thesis will be the same as for the submission of grades for that particular semester for which the student has registered. However, during the break period, thesis can be submitted with a late fee of Rs 200/- per day up to 20 days or date of registration of next semester whichever is earlier. No further relaxation will be granted.

In above quoted rule, it is clearly mentioned that the last date for submission of thesis will be the same as for the submission of grades for that particular semester (i.e. 26th July, 2022 for the 2nd semester of the academic year 2021-22) for which the student has registered and further relaxation with a late fee of Rs 200/- per day up to 20 days or date of registration of next semester whichever is earlier.

In previous academic years, these types of requests were received from the PG students regarding extension in due date of thesis submission/thesis seminar and same requests have been made by the PG students for current semester i.e. 2nd semester of Academic Year 2021-22.

In view of above, the matter was placed before the RIC and suggestions of all RIC members were sought for the same to avoid such types of problems in future.

The RIC discussed the matter at length and decided to recommend the following changes in the Rule 14.6 (c) of Chapter III of University Calendar Volume II for consideration and approval by the Academic Council.

Rule No.	Existing	Proposed
14.6	(c) Thesis/ dissertation shall be submitted along with proforma PG-9. The last date for submission of thesis will be the same as for the submission of grades for that particular semester for which the student has registered. However, during the break period, thesis can be submitted with a late fee of Rs 200/- per day up to 20 days or date of registration of next semester whichever is earlier. No further relaxation will be granted.	(c) Thesis/dissertation shall be submitted along with proforma PG-9. The last date for submission of thesis will be up to one day before the date of registration of next semester. Also thesis seminar can be delivered during the break period up to one day before the date of registration of the next semester. No further relaxation will be granted.

Therefore, the RIC recommended to place the matter before the Worthy Vice-Chancellor for granting necessary approval subject to the ratification by the Academic Council in its ensuing meeting.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
