At the outset, the Chairman welcomed all the members of Board of Studies and the following decisions were taken:

**Item No. 1: Confirmation of the Proceedings of the 209<sup>th</sup> Meeting of Board of Studies, COVS held on 18/12/10.**

**Item No. 2: Creation of additional NRI seats (twelve) for B.V.Sc.& A.H. programme (revised agenda):**

In the 209<sup>th</sup> meeting of Board of Studies of College of Veterinary Sciences held on 31/12/10 at 10.30 a.m., it was decided to introduce 12 (twelve) additional seats for NRI students as per the following details:

- (i) The admission under this category will be given only to NRIs, their children/wards. The eligibility requirements for these programmes is the same as for general category candidates. However, the candidates who have completed their qualifying examination or equivalent abroad are required to submit a copy of their certificate/ transcript/marks sheet

indicating grades and % equivalent marks, duly verified and certified by the Indian Embassy/ High Commission in that country, stating that such examination is equivalent to the qualifying examination (10+2) of Indian Universities. In addition, they will also be required to submit an application for obtaining the requisite equivalence certificate from the Registrar CCS HAU Hisar by paying a fee of US\$ 500 (non refundable) through a bank draft in favour of Dean, College of Vety. Sciences, CCSHAU, Hisar payable at any scheduled bank at Hisar.

- (ii) The NRI candidates seeking admission to B.V.Sc. & A.H. programme will be considered for admission without appearing in the entrance test of the university provided they have passed 12<sup>th</sup> standard level examination with 50% marks in aggregate in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English for B.V.Sc.&A.H. programme, subject to verification of its equivalence with the 10+2 examination (Medical Group) of the Central Board of Secondary Education/ Board of School Education, Haryana by an appropriate authority. The detail of subjects studied, grades and % equivalent marks obtained is to be furnished in the NRI application form.

### 2. Financial Assistance for Hostellers in Meals

Financial assistance to the tune of Rs. 25/- per student per month shall be allowed to those hostellers who have their meals in the hostel mess.

### 3. Number and Value of Scholarships/Stipends

The Scholarships/Stipends shall be awarded only to candidates admitted against Haryana seats on the basis of the merit list prepared (for admission) in accordance with the rules relating to award of Scholarships and Stipends by the University as given in University Calendar Vol.II.

#### a) Scholarships

The University awards merit scholarship of Rs. 1000/- to each student per month. This scholarship is however, offered to only 25% of those students who have been admitted against the Haryana Resident seats. The amount of scholarship will be Rs. 1500/- per month if the recipient is a girl student. If an occasion arises for re-award of scholarships, the number of scholarships is determined by the strength of the class at the time of re-award. After award of scholarships, when the fraction is half or more than half, it is to be taken as one for the purpose of award of scholarship.

**b) Stipends**

A student enrolled for Master's programme possessing an OGPA of 7.0/10.0 at the time of admission for Ist semester and thereafter maintain/acquire OGPA of 7.5/10.0
