At the outset, the Chairman welcomed all the members of Board of Studies and the following decisions were taken:

Item No.1: Confirmation of the proceedings of the 219th meeting of Board of Studies, COVS held on 14.11.2011 at 2.15 p.m.

Item No.2: Offering of Course No.ES-200 to the 2nd year BVSc.&AH students

As per directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court and adopted by the Academic Council of CCS HAU, Hisar, the above mentioned course i.e. ES-200 (Environmental Sciences) was used to be offered to the 2nd year BVSc&AH students in the 2nd Semester. However, in the new VCI Regulations (2008) a course i.e. VPE-511 (Environment & Environmental Hygiene) has been included in the undergraduate course curriculum, the contents of which are comparable with the contents of ES-200. The members discussed the issue at length and it was concluded that, since the contents of the course VPE-511 were similar to the contents of Course No.ES-200. Therefore, the course No.ES-200 may be deleted after approval by the Academic Council, LLRUVAS, Hisar

Item No.3: Admission in Ph.D. Programme in the 2nd Semester in some Departments:

Dr.Amandeep Singh has applied for admission in Ph.D. programme in the department of Veterinary Anatomy and he has requested that he has been

awarded the “inspire fellowship” which is a prestigious fellowship. The request from the department of Vety.Anatomy has also been received. Therefore, in the interest of the department and the student, one additional seat may be created in the 2nd semester, 2011-12 so that the student may not be debarred from availing the prestigious fellowship. The agenda was approved as proposed.

Item No.4: Approval of Curriculum of “Veterinary Laboratory Technician Diploma”

A proposal was received through the Director-General, Animal husbandry & Dairying, Haryana for approval of curriculum for “Veterinary Laboratory Technician Diploma”. The curriculum was referred to a Committee and a Committee suggested certain modifications. Meanwhile, the COVS is also proposing a Laboratory Technician Diploma. The Board suggested that both the proposals be put up in the next meeting of BOS.

Item No.5: Possibilities of starting certificate courses and diploma course in the department of Animal Nutrition:

The agenda was discussed in detail and the following decisions were taken:

- i) The duration of course will be 28 days
- ii) No. of candidates will be 20 (minimum 10)
- iii) Essential qualifications of the candidates 10+2 with Science stream (physics, chemistry, maths, biology, biotechnology or Life Sciences subjects if any as given in the CBSE regulations).
- iv) The date for opening and closing for admission will be notified in the prospectus of LLRUVAS.
- v) The reservation of categories will be followed as per prospectus of LLRUVAS.
- vi) No boarding/lodging will be provided for the candidates. The fee would be Rs.600/- for general category Rs. 150/- for SC&ST candidates.
- vii) No remuneration will be given to the resource persons.
- viii) The comprehensive syllabus and format will be framed by the Department of Animal Nutrition.
- ix) The justification, objective and contents of the training course were approved as proposed by the Department of Animal Nutrition.

Item No. 6: Starting of certificate course and diploma programme from the year 2012-13:

The HOD, LPM showed his inability to outline the syllabus for the aforesaid diploma programme, since contents of the course have to be covered from 4 different departments, therefore, more time is required for outlining the course contents. The agenda was deferred and the HOD, LPM was requested to submit the syllabus for the said diploma at the earliest.
