Agenda Item No. 1. Confirmation of proceedings of 258th meeting of BOS held on 05.05.2018 at 08.00 AM.

Agenda Item No. 2. Request to add 10+2 (Non-medical) Science stream or 10+2 with any stream in eligibility norms- Demand of Association of Private VLDD Colleges.

It was decided that the minimum educational qualifications for admission to DVLTC Courses through Entrance Test will not be changed and it will be retained as 2.10 (i) in the prospectus. The minimum educational qualifications for admission to VLDD Course through Entrance Test were changed as 2.10 (ii) in the prospectus as given below in tabular form.

<p>2.10</p> <p>Minimum educational qualifications for admission to VLDD and DVLTT Courses through Entrance Test:</p> <p>The candidates under all categories must have passed in each of the subjects of 10+2 with Physics, Chemistry & Biology and obtained a minimum of 45% marks in aggregate (Except SC category) from a recognized/ approved board of school education having equivalence by council of Boards of School Education (COBSE), New Delhi/CBSE/ICSE and also by Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani. As per Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana letter no. 22/129/ 2013-1GSIII dated 16.07.2014, the SC category candidates will be allowed a relaxation up to 5% of the requirement for General Category i.e. the SC candidates securing a minimum of 42.75% marks in aggregate of the subjects mentioned above will be eligible to apply for admission.</p>	<p>2.10</p> <p>(i) Minimum educational qualifications for admission to DVLTT Course through Diploma Entrance Test:</p> <p>The candidates under all categories must have passed in each of the subjects of 10+2 with Physics, Chemistry & Biology and obtained a minimum of 45% marks in aggregate (Except SC category) from a recognized/ approved board of school education having equivalence by council of Boards of School Education (COBSE), New Delhi/CBSE/ICSE and also by Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani. As per Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana letter no. 22/129/ 2013-1GSIII dated 16.07.2014, the SC category candidates will be allowed a relaxation up to 5% of the requirement for General Category i.e. the SC candidates securing a minimum of 42.75% marks in aggregate of the subjects mentioned above will be eligible to apply for admission.</p> <p>(ii) Minimum educational qualifications for admission to VLDD Course through Diploma Entrance Test:</p> <p>a) The candidate must have passed in each of the subjects of 10+2 examination from any stream.</p> <p>b) The candidates under all categories must have passed matriculation/ 10th standard examination and obtained a minimum of 60% marks in aggregate (Except SC category) from a recognized/ approved board of school education having equivalence by Council of Boards of School Education (COBSE), New Delhi/ CBSE/ ICSE and also by Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani. As per Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana letter no. 22/129/ 2013-1GSIII dated 16.07.2014, the SC category candidates will be allowed a relaxation up to 5% of the requirement for General Category i.e. the SC candidates securing a minimum of 57% marks in aggregate in matriculation/10th standard examination. The syllabus of entrance test will be of matriculation/ 10th standard examination of Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani/ CBSE, New Delhi.</p>

Agenda Item No. 3. To increase in the intake capacity for VLDD admission 2018-19 in the International Institute of Veterinary Education & Research, Bahu Akbarpur, Rohtak (Haryana)

The Board of Studies, COVS, LUVAS took cognizance of the report of Inspection Committee and it was decided that a letter of displeasure may be sent to IIVER authorities on account of misbehavior with members of Inspection Committee.

The Board of Studies approved 78 seats (4 seats in addition to existing 74 seats) for admission to VLDD Course at IIVER, Bahu Akbarpur for the year 2018-19.

Agenda Item No. 4. Amendment in Norms, Procedure and Guidelines for affiliation of institutions offering/desirous of starting Veterinary and Livestock Development (VLD) Diploma course in the State of Haryana, rule no. 11.

The following change in Rule 11 of Norms, Procedure and Guidelines for affiliation of Institutions offering/ desirous of starting VLD Diploma courses was approved as given below in tabular form.

Existing Provision	Approved Provision
11) All the students admitted in the affiliated institutions shall register themselves with the College of Veterinary Sciences, LUVAS, Hisar after paying the prescribed registration fee (which will include academic examination and other annual charges (incidental thereof) each year as per schedule prescribed by the College. The representatives of concerned Institutes will have to present themselves at the time of counseling for their Institute for 50% of the seats to be filled by the LUVAS at LUVAS, Campus. Similarly, two representatives of Director, Institute of Para Veterinary Sciences to be decided in consultation with Dean, COVS will be present in the concerned Institute on the day of counseling for admission of 50 % seats of their management quota.	11) The Process of Registration and Counselling for admission to VLD Diploma in the affiliated institutions will be online & payment of fees will be as per prospectus displayed on LUVAS website.


