As per LUVAS Prospectus 2024-25, admission to M.V.Sc. and Ph.D Programme will be held in the 2nd semester of academic year 2024-25 and Admission forms for M.V.Sc. and Ph.D. are required to be uploaded on university website on **10.03.2025**.

In view of the above, the Counselling schedule for admission to M.V.Sc. and Ph.D. are required to be finalized for uploading on university website for information of intending candidates.

It is pertinent to mention here that the admission form for M.V.Sc. and Ph.D. will be available on university website from 10.03.2025 to 08.04.2025 as per LUVAS Prospectus 2024-25.

In addition to the above, Admission forms and Admission Notice for M.V.Sc. and Ph.D. are also required to be uploaded on university website. Further, Admission Notice for M.V.Sc. and Ph.D. Programmes is also required to be published in any two newspapers for wide publicity.

The RIC discussed the matter at length and recommended to place the matter before the worthy Vice-Chancellor for seeking approval subject to the ratification by the Academic Council in its ensuing meeting.

Further, RIC recommended the Draft Admission Notice may be got approved from the Worthy Vice-Chancellor for uploading on university website and publishing in any two newspapers for wide publicity.

Agenda Item No.69 RIC-4: Request of students regarding admission on the basis of own Entrance Test of LUVAS for M.V.Sc. Programme.

Some students have submitted requests for conducting the separate Entrance Test by LUVAS for admission to M.V.Sc. Programme, whereas many students have also submitted request for admission of the student in M.V.Sc. Programme should be made on the basis of NTA-AIEEA (All India Entrance Examination for Admission) PG-2024 which is being already adopted by the LUVAS in the Prospectus of 2024-25.

The RIC discussed the matter at length and all the RIC members were of view that to change admission criteria at this stage for admission to M.V.Sc. programme may invite legal complication as it is already mentioned in the LUVAS prospectus 2024-25 that admission will be made on the basis of NTA-AIEEA (All India Entrance Examination for Admission) PG-2024.

Therefore, RIC unanimously decided that admission to M.V.Sc. programme for the Academic year 2024-25 should be made on the basis of NTA-AIEEA (All India Entrance

Examination for Admission) as per past two academic years i.e. 2022-23 and 2023-24 to avoid legal complication.
