



AUCTION NOTICE

Total one hundred and nine animals (females and males of Hardhenu, Hariana and Sahiwal cattle) of this Department will be auctioned on **13.10.2025 at 10.00 a.m.** at the Cattle Farm of College of Veterinary Sciences, LUVAS, Hisar.

Interested persons are requested to reach the spot and bid for these animals. The auction shall be conducted on the following terms and conditions:

1. The animals shall be sold by open auction.
2. The animals shall be sold to the highest bidder subject to the approval of the auction committee.
3. Committee may reject any bid without assigning any reason.
4. The bidder will have to deposit a security amount of Rs. 10000/- per bid as earnest money along with photocopy of Aadhar card.
5. Only those bidders who have deposited security amount along with photocopy of Aadhar card will be allowed to enter premises of Animal farm, College of Vety. Science, LUVAS, Hisar.
6. Interested bidders can check records related to health and reproduction status of animals before auction. Department will not be responsible for any disease or incident after the auction of animals.
7. The auctioned animals will be delivered to the successful bidder only after verifying the identity of original bidder.
8. For unsuccessful bidders, the earnest money will be refunded upon completion of the auction process after in-person verification of identity.
9. After successful bid, there will be no responsibility of institution in case of any kind of incident/death.
10. The successful bidder shall have to make the payment in cash within three working days after the day of auction.
11. After depositing the full payment, gate pass with vehicle registration number will be issued to the successful bidder by the concerned officer.
12. The auctioned animals shall have to be removed within three working days after the day of auction is over, failing which the bidder has to pay Rs. 100/- per day per animal as feeding charges. If the successful bidder fails to remove the animals from the farm within 10 days after the day of auction, the auction of those animals will be treated as cancelled and the amount paid by the bidder will be forfeited.
13. The successful bidder shall be responsible for loading the animals in their vehicle.
14. The successful bidder shall be responsible for obtaining the necessary permit for transporting the animals in or out of the state of Haryana.
15. The auction committee reserves the exclusive right to accept or reject any bid during the auction.
16. The auction committee reserves the exclusive right to modify or clarify any terms during the auction.
17. In case of any dispute, the decision of the auction committee shall be final.
18. Jurisdiction of Hisar Court will apply for any legal action in the court of law, in case of any dispute.
