At the outset, the Chairman, welcomed all the Hon'ble members and special invitees and wished that the contribution of members in the meeting will be constructive and useful.

Thereafter, the following agenda items were discussed and decision taken thereof:

- Agenda item No.75 RIC-1:** Confirmation of the proceedings of the 74th meeting held on 10.09.2025.

- Agenda item No.75 RIC-2:** Action taken report on the proceedings of 74th meeting held on 10.09.2025.
Noted and approved
- Agenda item No. 75 RIC-3:** Amendment in rules of Chapter III and Chapter III A of University Calendar Volume II regarding written Preliminary Comprehensive Examinations (PCE) of Masters and Doctorate students.

As per provision contained under rules 8.2(a) of Chapter III and 8.3(a) of Chapter III A of University Calendar Volume II, the written Preliminary Comprehensive Examination (PCE) of Ph.D. student will be conducted for both the major and minor disciplines on completion of at least 75% of the course work, including minor and supporting subjects. Further, the written Preliminary Comprehensive Examination (PCE) for **Masters' programmes** will be conducted externally (one paper) in **Major Subject only** on completion of at least 75% of the course work, including minor and supporting subjects as per provision contained under rule 8.1 of Chapter III A of University Calendar Volume II.

In compliance with the aforesaid rules, written Preliminary Comprehensive Examination (PCE) of Ph.D. and Masters' students is conducted by the office of Dean, PGS after completion of 75% of the course work. After declaration of written PCE result, some aggrieved students have requested for scrutiny of their written PCE answer sheet on the pattern of B.V.Sc. & A. H. programme. However, there is no provision under rules mentioned in Chapter III and III A of UCV-II for scrutiny of the written PCE answer sheets.

In view of the position explained above, following additions are proposed in rules 8.1 and 8.3(a) of Chapter III A and 8.2(a) of Chapter III and of University Calendar Volume II.

Additions of point No. vi to xi in rule 8.1 of Chapter III A for Masters' PCE are as under:

- (vi) There will be no re-evaluation of the written Preliminary Comprehensive Examination (PCE) answer -book(s).
- (vii) A student, however, may be allowed to get his or her written Preliminary Comprehensive Examination (PCE) answer book(s) scrutinised, for which, the student shall have to apply

- to Dean, PGS within three working days after the declaration of result and after paying prescribed fee of 1000/- per paper.
- (viii) The Dean, PGS shall arrange the scrutiny of answer book(s) by the Screening Committee to be constituted by the Dean, PGS.
 - (ix) The scrutiny shall be for re-totalling of the marks, and evaluation of unmarked question(s), if any.
 - (x) In case, the total marks are found to be incorrect on scrutiny, the same shall be corrected and the result shall be revised accordingly (even if it is towards lower side) and if, any question is found to be unchecked by the examiner, the answer book(s) shall be sent to the examiner for doing the needful and the result(s) shall be revised accordingly if there occurs any change in the marks.
 - (xi) No representation by the student(s) shall be entertained regarding the outcome of the result after scrutiny.

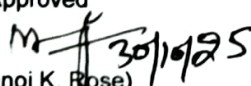
Additions of point No. xii to xvii in rule 8.2(a) of Chapter III and 8.3(a) of Chapter III A for doctoral PCE are as under:

- (xii) There will be no re-evaluation of written Preliminary Comprehensive Examination (PCE) answer -book(s).
- (xiii) A student, however, may be allowed to get his or her written Preliminary Comprehensive Examination (PCE) answer book(s) scrutinised, for which, the student shall have to apply to Dean, PGS within three working days after the declaration of result and after paying prescribed fee of 1000/- per paper.
- (xiv) The Dean, PGS shall arrange the scrutiny of answer book(s) by the Screening Committee to be constituted by the Dean, PGS.
- (xv) The scrutiny shall be for re-totalling of the marks, and evaluation of unmarked question(s), if any.
- (xvi) In case, the total marks are found to be incorrect on scrutiny, the same shall be corrected and the result shall be revised accordingly (even if it is towards lower side) and if, any question is found to be unchecked by the examiner, the answer book(s) shall be sent to the examiner for doing the needful and the result(s) shall be revised accordingly if there occurs any change in the marks.
- (xvii) No representation by the student(s) shall be entertained regarding the outcome of the result after scrutiny.

The RIC discussed the matter at length and recommended that the addition under the aforementioned rules be implemented with effect from the second semester of the Academic Year 2024-25.

Further, the RIC recommended to place the matter before the worthy Vice-Chancellor for seeking approval subject to the ratification by the Academic Council in its ensuing meeting.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.

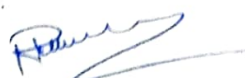
