

Approved Constitution and Bye-Laws of Pranvayu Club

Preamble:

The purpose of the Club is to raise awareness to take proactive measures to mitigate pollution, conservation of natural resources and promoting the green way of life in a sustainable way.

Objectives:

1. To motivate the students to keep their surroundings clean and green.
2. To celebrate environment related events with promotional activities.
3. To organize cleanliness drives in University, Hisar city and nearby villages.
4. To promote use of renewable sources of energy for meeting out energy requirement of the university.
5. To educate the students, staff, faculty and the community about reuse and recycling of waste material.
6. To organize tree plantation drives in the university preferably with medicinal plants, fruit plants and endangered species of plants.
7. To organize awareness programs such as quiz, essay, poster and painting competitions, rallies, nukad natak etc. regarding various environmental issues.
8. To sensitize the University community and the society to minimize use of non-biodegradable materials so as to avoid choking of drains and sewers.
9. To promote eco-friendly transportation system in the University.

Organization and operation of the Club:-

Patron: Vice-Chancellor

Controlling Officer: DSW-cum-E.O will have the overall control on the club and will be responsible to the Vice-Chancellor.

President: One of the Coordinators (General) will be nominated as President of Pranvayu Club by the Worthy Vice-Chancellor. The president will be responsible for planning of various activities as per objectives of the club and initiation of proposal through ADSW (General) to the DSW-cum-EO for approval from the Vice-Chancellor.

Secretary and treasurer: The junior most faculty member amongst the nominated members will be the Secretary of the Club and next senior will be the treasurer.

Members

Coordinators (General):

All the Co-ordinators (General) will be the members of the Pranvayu club and will facilitate in achieving the objectives through ADSW (General) as per the direction of DSW-cum-E.O.

Members from Faculty:

To begin with, three faculty members from COVS and one from CODST will be nominated by the respective Deans as per their interest and activities in saving the environment and personal interaction with them.

In addition, two members from faculty will be nominated by Worthy Vice-chancellor after personal interaction with them. The tenure will be of two years.

Student members:

One student from each UG and Diploma class as per their overall performance in curricular, co-curricular and extracurricular activities will be nominated by concerned Dean/Director, IPVS. Two PG and two PhD. students from COVS and One PG and one PhD. student from CODST will be nominated by the Dean, PGS. Tenure of the nominated students will be of one year. No student will be inducted for the second time.

Arrangement of funds:

Funds will be arranged from NGOs, Private Organizations, Associations, Individuals etc. in the form of funds or kinds. Efforts will be made to make the Club self-reliant. The University will not provide any funds for the activities under the aegis of the club.

Account of the Club:

The account will be opened in the name of Pranvayu Club in any Bank and will be operated by President and treasurer both.

Maintenance and audit of account:

The account of the club will be audited in the month December every year by one of the official not below Superintendent nominated by the Comptroller.

Membership fees

Members of the Pranvayu Club will be made from NGOs, Private Organizations, Associations and Individuals etc. The annual membership fees will be as given below:-

- Students Members Rs. 200/-
- University Employee/Individuals Members Rs. 500/-
- NGOs Private Organizations/ Associations Rs. 1000/-
