At the outset, the Chairman, welcomed all the Hon'ble members and special invitees and wished that the contribution of members in the meeting will be constructive and useful.

Thereafter, the following agenda items were discussed and decision taken thereof:

**Agenda Item No. 79 RIC-3: Post Facto permission to M.V.Sc. student Dr Vinay Kumar, Admn. No. 2023V19M (VGO), regarding registration for thesis viva-voce examination.**

It is submitted that Dr Vinay Kumar (Admn. No. 2023V19M) was admitted to the M.V.Sc. programme in the discipline of Animal Reproduction Gynaecology and Obstetrics (ARGO) during the 2nd semester of the academic year 2023-24. He submitted his thesis on 02.04.2026 after completion of final term examination of 1st semester, 2025-26 (i.e. 4<sup>th</sup> semester of his study).

Thereafter, his thesis viva-voce examination was scheduled on 22.05.2026 in consultation with his Major Advisor, HoD, VGO and the External Examiner, and the same was conducted as per the scheduled date.

Meanwhile, it came to notice that the student has not registered for the Thesis Viva-Voce Examination within the prescribed schedule during the 5th semester (i.e. 2nd semester, 2025-26). Further, the period permissible for registration with late fee @ Rs. 300/- per day up to 15 days has also expired. Therefore, the result of the thesis viva-voce in respect of aforesaid student is kept on hold.

Provisions contained under rule 2.2 of Chapter III A of University Calendar Volume II regarding registration are produced as under:

2.2 Registration for the first semester of the programme is a part of admission and is governed by admission rules. Registration for subsequent semesters shall take place on the dates notified in Academic Calendar and shall be governed by the following schedule:

(a) *Advisement and registration (Appendix-I) without late fee on the prescribed date (s) which shall be one or two days prior to the commencement of classes. However, registration for thesis submission and/ or viva-voce shall be allowed with a nominal fee of Rs. 2000/- during the scheduled date of registration of the semester.*

- (b) *Registration with late fee of Rs 300/- per day up to 15 days, is permissible. Late fee is not to be exempted under any circumstance. No registration shall be permissible after 15 days of the commencement of classes. Late registration is not applicable to the freshly admitted students.*
- (c) *No attendance benefit for late registration will be allowed.*

The registration schedule for the 2nd Semester of the Academic Year 2025–26 has already been notified in the Academic Calendar of the PG Programme for the Academic Year 2025–26, circulated by this office vide Memo No. LUVAS/PGS/Acad/2025/2350–2395 dated 25.09.2025.

Subsequently, the student submitted an application, duly recommended and forwarded by his Major Advisor and HoD, VGO, stating that he had inadvertently missed the registration for the Thesis Viva-Voce Examination in the 5th semester (i.e. 2nd semester, 2025-26). In this regard, comments from the Major Advisor and HoD, VGO were obtained by the office of Dean, PGS.

Accordingly, Dr Jasmer (Assistant Prof., Dept. of VGO) Major Advisor of the student, has submitted that upon enquiry, the student informed that he had suffered a nasal bone fracture and remained on complete bed rest from 30.04.2026 to 19.05.2026. Further, the Major Advisor has requested that, on humanitarian and sympathetic ground, the student may allow to register for the Thesis Viva-Voce Examination with such late fee as may be decided by the competent authority, as per rules and norms.

The comments of the Major Advisor and the Head of the Department, VGO, along with documentary proof regarding the advised bed rest issued by the ENT Specialist, are enclosed with the student's application.

Therefore, in view of the position explained above, the matter of agenda item was placed before the RIC for consideration and decision, please.

The RIC discussed the matter at length and unanimously recommended that

1. Post facto permission may be granted to M.V.Sc. student Dr. Vinay Kumar, Admission No. 2023V19M (VGO), for registration for the thesis viva-voce examination with payment of a late fee of ₹300 per day from the date of commencement of classes of the 2nd Semester, 2025–26 (i.e. 04.05.2026), up to 22.05.2026, along with a nominal fee of ₹2,000.
2. The post facto permission granted in respect of the aforesaid student shall be treated as a one-time measure only and shall not be quoted or considered as a precedent in any future case.

Further, RIC recommended to place the matter before the worthy Vice-Chancellor for seeking approval subject to the ratification by the Academic Council in its ensuing meeting.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
