The National Academy of Veterinary Sciences (India) is an apex premier agency for the development of Veterinary Sciences in India that was established on lines similar to the National Academy of Medical Sciences by eminent visionary Veterinarians to promote and consolidate the scientific views on policy matters related to Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry and to strive for advancement of livestock sector in national economy through promotion of animal welfare. It has been registered by the Registrar of Societies, Delhi vide Registration Certificate No. S-2/4471 of 1993 dated 7th July, 1993 and has emerged as the largest think-tank of all branches of the profession for research & development departments of the country engaged in Animal Husbandry & Veterinary sectors. The Academy was established to promote the interests of Veterinarians in the country and was launched with Dr. Chinta Mani Singh, regarded as the doyen of Veterinary Services in India, as its Founder President. About the Host University - LUVAS

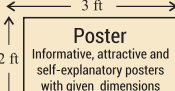
