Course Background

Veterinary Surgery has evolved considerably over the past decades, driven by technological innovations, advancements in diagnostic imaging, improved understanding of animal diseases, surgical techniques, anaesthesia, and postoperative care. Farm and companion animal surgeries are transforming making procedures less invasive, more precise and safer with improved perioperative protocols, improving recovery, reducing risks and enhancing long-term outcomes, enabling veterinarians to manage complex conditions more safely and effectively, thereby increasing the scope and success rate of veterinary surgical interventions. Furthermore, heightened awareness of animal welfare and the economic & emotional value placed on animals have contributed in increasing the demand for specialized surgical interventions.

Course Contents

The training will provide required theoretical and practical knowledge pertaining to different diagnostic modalities and treatment techniques for different disorders of farm and companion animals. The talks on topics are interwoven with simple practical exercises, discussion, and hands-on-training, so as to make sure that attendees understand the concepts and learn the different surgical techniques to be able to replicate the same at their place. The present course will mainly include the different topics on farm and companion animals related to:

1. Anesthetic Techniques
2. Radiography
3. Ultrasonography
4. Endoscopy
5. Rumenotomy and Diaphragmatic Herniorrhaphy
6. Soft tissue surgery
7. Orthopaedics
8. Ophthalmology
9. Neurosurgery
10. Physiotherapy

Duration of course: 21 days (Jan 21 – Feb 10, 2026)
Last date to apply: 20th December, 2025
Number of participants: 25 (Twenty-five)

Eligibility

- Master's Degree in Veterinary Surgery and Radiology or in any other allied subject in Veterinary Sciences. The applicant should not be below the rank of Assistant Professor and equivalent and should be working under Veterinary Universities/ Agricultural Universities/ ICAR Institutes

How to apply

- The participants submit the duly filled and approved application form to the Course Director-cum-Professor & Head through e-mail hod.vsr@luvas.edu.in with a copy to dr.deepaktiwari@luvas.edu.in
- After filling the application form, take a print out of the application form and get it approved by the competent authority.
- Scan the application form and send the approved application form through e- mail to the Course Director on or before 20th Dec, 2025.
- Selected participants will be informed through e-mail.
- The selected candidates will be required to submit the original application form duly approved by the competent authority at the time of registration along with Demand Draft of ₹50/- as registration fee (non-refundable) in favour of 'Comptroller LUVAS' and payable at State Bank of India, HAU Branch, Hisar (IFSC Code: SBIN0001566)

Travel

- Hisar is well connected through buses 24x7 from neighbouring states as well as Delhi [Inter State Bus Terminus (ISBT) at Kashmiri Gate]. Trains for Hisar could be taken from Delhi: 12555/Gorakhdham SF Express (Departure from New Delhi at 05:30 A.M.); 14731/Kisan Express (Departure from Old Delhi Station at 02:00 P.M.); 14085/Sirsa Express (Departure from New Delhi at 17:55 Hours).
- Travel Allowance to the participants will be paid for the journey, to and fro, as per their entitlement for the class of travel, restricted to the maximum of AC II tier rail fare by the shortest route. Participants are required to produce money receipt/ tickets in support of their claim. The reimbursement will be made as per ICAR guidelines. The candidates are advised to make their reservation in advance.

Boarding and lodging

- Accommodation will be available on twin sharing basis in University Guest House.

Weather

- The weather during January/February at Hisar will be cold (winter season). The participants are advised to carry woolen clothes.

About the Department

The Department started as Department of Medicine and Surgery in 1948, became functioning as full fledged Department of Veterinary Surgery and Radiology in 1966. The Department of Surgery and Radiology has the mandate for teaching and research. Apart from offering courses to the students of B.V.Sc. & A.H. programme, the department offers M. V. Sc. and Ph. D. degree. The department has a well equipped radiology section to provide diagnostic services for small and large animals. Clinical camps and clinical conferences are held routinely at district level of the Haryana State to provide short courses/ refresher training to the field veterinarians and to extract information about the problems. Short term training courses are arranged from time to time for scientists and teachers from other institutes. This department has made landmark achievements in the subject and is considered one of the best in the country. The faculty members of this department have always followed time honoured tradition of team work and made collective efforts to maintain high standards of teaching and research. The students and teachers of this department are holding or have held top positions in the institutes/ organizations/ profession. Many of them have been on foreign teaching assignments. First Ph.D. in Veterinary Surgery and Radiology in India was awarded from this department. First large animal X-ray machine in India was installed in this department. The idea of forming Indian Society for Veterinary Surgery was mooted in this department and society was formed with headquarters here in 1977.

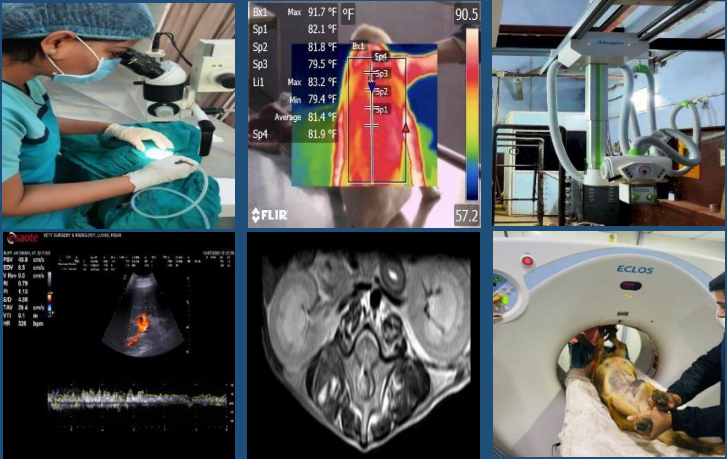
About the University

Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Hisar was established by the Government of Haryana on 01st December, 2010 in the pursuance of the Haryana Act No. 7 of 2010 notified on 7th April, 2010. The university has its own campus of 1124 acres. The College of Veterinary Sciences is one of the oldest veterinary colleges in North India. From Lyallpur (currently in Pakistan), the campus at Hisar was shifted consequent to partition of India. The college has 18 departments with well qualified faculty and modern laboratory infrastructure. In addition to the College of Veterinary Sciences, the university also houses the College of Dairy Science and Technology and the Institute of Para Veterinary Sciences, which serves the needs of dairy farmers, animal owners and other stakeholders.
