1. Academic Qualifications 40 marks

For Bachelor's degree: 20 Marks on Pro-rata basis.

For Master's degree: 20 Marks on Pro-rata basis.

The calculation on pro-rata basis will be as per Annexure-1-A and Annexure-1-B, respectively.

2. Additional Qualifications 13 marks

i)	*Ph.D. Degree	10 Marks
ii)	a) Diploma course in relevant field of not less than 01 year duration from a recognized University/Institute. (one mark for each)	Max. 03 Marks
	b) Certificate course in relevant field of not less than 01 year duration from a recognized University/Institute. (one mark for each)	
	c) Certificate course in relevant field of not less than 06 months duration from a recognized University/Institute. (0.5 mark for each)	

* **For Ph.D. degree:** 10 marks on Pro-rata basis.

The calculation on pro-rata basis will be as per Annexure-1-C.

System/formula for converting the OGPA system into percentage of marks:-

- (a) The candidates who come from other Universities/Institutions where percentage of marks is awarded along-with OGPA, the percentage of marks as awarded by the concerned University/Institution will be considered and no further conversion is required.

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- (b) In case of other Universities/Institutions where no equivalent percentage of marks is expressly provided, but the conversion formula of the OGPA awarded has been given by the concerned University/Institution, the percentage of marks would be obtained by using the conversion formula of that University/Institution.
- (c) In case of other Universities/Institutions where no equivalent percentage of marks is given or no formula for conversion of the OGPA is expressly provided, the percentage of marks will be calculated on the basis of the following simple linear formula.

Example:

(i)	If a candidate gets 4 on a scale of 5, his percentage of marks would be	$\frac{4 \times 100}{5} = 80\%$
(ii)	If a candidate gets an OGPA of 7 on a scale of 10, his percentage of marks will be	$\frac{7 \times 100}{10} = 70\%$
(iii)	If a candidate gets 3 on a scale of 4, his percentage of marks will be	$\frac{3 \times 100}{4} = 75\%$

Note: For the candidates who have obtained Ph.D. degree without course work, the marks will be awarded on pro-rata basis corresponding to minimum qualifying marks for award of Ph.D. degree in LUVAS.

3. Experience

05 marks

- (a) One mark shall be given for each completed year of experience in teaching/research/extension in the cadre of Assistant Professor or equivalent in regular service in the University/College/Institution funded by State/Central Govt.
- (b) Post-Doctoral Research - One mark shall be given for each completed year of experience in any Institute/University at International Level or at any University/College/Institution at National Level funded by State/Central Govt.
- (c) Research Associate (RA)-0.75 mark for each completed year in a University/College/Institution funded by State/Central Govt.
- (d) Senior Research Fellow (SRF)- 0.50 mark for each completed year in a University/College/Institution funded by State/Central Govt.

Note 1:- Time spent for obtaining Ph.D. shall not be counted towards experience. The fragmented experience will not be considered for scoring and no mark of experience shall be awarded for any period less than one year. For example :- If a candidate has gained three experiences from same/different organisations with continuous or break of period mentioned as under :

1st experience of 1 year 3 months,

2nd experience of 6 months,

3rd experience of 1 year 9 months

Then he/she will be given only two marks if fragmented (1 year 3 months = 1 mark; 6 months = 0 mark; 1 year 9 months = 1 mark) and 3 marks if continuous (1 year 3 months + 6 months + 1 year 9 months = 3 years 6 months = 3 marks).

Note 2:- A candidate will be liable for rejection if his work and conduct in the past is not found to be satisfactory. For this purpose, the candidate would have to attach/submit a character certificate from the Institution last attended and/or from his last employer.
