The new University has been named in the cherished memory of Lala Lajpat Rai, a great patriot, the foremost freedom fighter, an ardent social reformer and a versatile writer. Lala Lajpat Rai, popularly known as “Punjab Kesri”, did his early legal practice at Hisar and also served as a Member and Secretary of the Hisar Municipality. The College of Veterinary Sciences has a glorious history of more than 60 years, since it was shifted to Hisar from Lahore (Pakistan). It is backed by an enviable track record of academic excellence, cutting edge research and rendering quality services to the livestock of the state. An extensive network of alumni occupying important positions throughout the world is a source of inspiration, enthusiasm and commitment to hard work for the faculty and students.

About Department:

The Department of Veterinary Parasitology was established in December, 1948 and is engaged in teaching, research and extension activities. The Department is involved in teaching of two UG courses (for Veterinary and Diploma in Veterinary Laboratory Techniques students) and over 20 PG courses (for Veterinary only). Besides this, trainings for disease investigation officers have been undertaken by the Department. A total of around 100 students have completed their post-graduation degree (M.V.Sc. and Ph.D.) from the Department of Veterinary Parasitology, who have bagged several prestigious national and international awards in the credit of the Department. The faculty of the Department has published ten books, over hundred book chapters, seventeen practical teaching manuals and several research articles in journals of national and international repute.

About Program:

Skin examination for parasitic diseases is a critical component of veterinary dermatology, dedicated to the detection and management of skin conditions in animals and birds caused by parasites. Clinicians perform skin examinations to identify the etiological agent. The assessment includes careful observation of skin and fur textures, as well as the presence of parasites, such as ticks, mites, lice and other parasites. In veterinary practice, common parasitic skin diseases in animals may include flea, lice, mite and tick infestations. Accurate identification of the parasitic species, which could be recovered during skin examination, is essential for diagnosis, treatment, prevention and control of the specific parasite involved. Regular training and staying updated on emerging parasitic threats in veterinary dermatology are essential for veterinarians to provide optimal care to animals affected with parasitic skin diseases. The training program aims to empower healthcare professionals with the knowledge and skills necessary to address the challenges posed by parasitic skin diseases. By focusing on understanding, recent diagnostic approaches, and effective treatment strategies for emerging threats, the participants will be benefitted under the umbrella of One Health.

Number of participants: The maximum number of participants shall not exceed 20 (minimum 10). Selection of candidates is completely based on first come first serve basis.

Participants and eligibility: Participants are invited from ICAR Institutes/SAU/State Governments/Private Organizations from India. Post graduate students, Veterinarians (Field as well as Private), and Faculty are encouraged to participate.

Course Fees: The program will be available on first come first serve basis with the payment of Rs. 500 for PG students of Veterinary/ Dairy Sciences, Rs. 1500 for Veterinarians (Field as well as Private) and Faculty of State/ICAR Institutes. There will be no registration fees for LUVAS faculty. The registration fee shall be deposited in the Department of Veterinary Parasitology.

How to apply: The application for participation must be sent via email (hod.vpa@luvas.edu.in) in duly prescribed format to the Course Director latest by 10/02/2024. Registration fee should be deposited in cash before or at the time of registration on 19.02.2024. The TA and DA of the participants will be borne by participants/sponsoring institutions/organizations, etc. The participants will also have to pay the boarding and lodging charges during the training program. The organizers of the course will not bear any expenses on account of the participants.

Duration: 03 (three) days

Contents of Course:

- 1. Skin scrapping examination and identification of mites of veterinary importance**
- 2. Importance of mite infestation in dermatological implications of animals and poultry birds**
- 3. Involvement of ticks in skin lesions of animals and birds**
- 4. Identification of tick genera of veterinary importance**
- 5. Dermatological manifestations of flea and louse infestations**
- 6. Identification of flea and louse species of veterinary importance**
- 7. Flies, protozoa and filarial worms: dermatological lesions in animals and birds**
- 8. Modified Knott's technique for concentration and identification of microfilariae**
