In pursuance of the decision taken by the PC/Board of Management vide item no. P-4/B-7 in its 12th / 30th meeting held on 20-05-2022 and 18-07-2022 respectively. It has been decided to institute a Gold Medal in the name of Dr. V. P. Dixit from the session 2021-22 with following terms and conditions.

1. The gold medal will be named as "**Dr. V.P. Dixit Gold Medal**" and will be awarded to the All Round Best Student.
2. The medal will be awarded after a student has successfully completed B.V. Sc.& A.H. degree in a particular Year from COVS, LUVAS.
3. All the general rules of the University for the Award of gold medals will be applicable to this medal.
4. The Committee consisting of the following will finalize the awardee of the medal and recommend to the Vice-Chancellor the award of Gold Medal for his approval:
 - i) Dean, COVS, LUVAS
 - ii) Director Students Welfare, LUVAS
 - iii) Registrar, LUVAS
5. The Vice-Chancellor, LUVAS, will be the deciding authority for the award of the Gold Medal. However, before the Medal is finally awarded, the name of the awardee shall be announced and objections, if any will be invited by the Dean, COVS. In case of any dispute or difference of opinion, the decision of the Vice-Chancellor, LUVAS shall be final.

It will be based upon the conversion figure already approved by the University. The marks earned will be halved for the 50 marks allotted for the present criteria. The five marks allotted for the courses of Veterinary Physiology will be awarded proportionate to the OGPA obtained by the student.


