MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences

(Hisar, Haryana, India)

and

University of Guelph (Guelph, Ontario, Canada)

WHEREAS both parties wish to explore areas of research co-operation in order to establish benefits to both institutions;

NOW THEREFORE both parties agree as follows:

1. **TERM AND TERMINATION**

This MOU will be valid for a period of three (3) years commencing on the date of last signature below. This MOU may be renewed by written mutual content of the parties in writing. Either party may terminate this MOU early upon ninety (90) days written notice to the other party.

2. **AUTHORISED REPRESENTATIVES**

Each party shall name an authorized Representative who shall be responsible for the negotiation of details for any future academic and educational co-operation.

3. **AREAS OF CO-OPERATION**

The parties hereto agree explore co-operation in areas of research which may include but is not limited to:

3.1. Livestock Agriculture;

3.2. Aquaculture

3.3. Food Science and

3.4. Veterinary Medicine.

4. **NO LEGAL OBLIGATIONS**

This parties agree that this MOU is not intended to be a legally binding agreement and imposes no financial obligations on either party. Both parties understand that any area of research co-operation will have to be negotiated and agreed upon under separate agreements.

5. **INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR) PRINCIPLES**

In negotiating the IPR terms in the separate agreements referred to in Article 4, the parties will consider the following principles:

- I. In case the research results are created solely by employees(s) and/or student(s) of a party, the employee(s), student(s) and/or party concerned alone will apply for grant of IPR and once granted, the IPR will be solely owned by the concerned employee(s), student(s) and/or party in accordance with that party's policies and collective agreements.
- II. In case of research results created jointly by employee(s) and/or student(s) of each party, the grant of IPR will be sought by the employee(s), student(s) and/or parties concerned jointly and once granted the IPR will be jointly owned by the concerned employee(s) students(s) and/or parties in accordance with the parties' respective policies and collective agreements.
- III. Any publication, document and/or paper created jointly by employee(s) and/or student(s) of each party in respect of work conducted pursuant to this MOU will be jointly owned by the concerned employee(s), student(s) and/or parties in accordance with the parties' respective policies and collective agreements. The use of the same logo and/or official emblem of a party or the name of its employee(s) or students(s) or any publication, document and/or paper, or in any publicity, promotion or advertisement will require prior permission of that party or its

employee(s) and/or student(s). It may however be ensured that the name, official emblem and logo is not misused.

Both parties agree to ensure protection or IPR generated from such co-operation consistent with their respective laws, rules and regulations and other international agreements to which both parties are signatures.


