1. THE AGREEMENT

This Memorandum of Understanding (“MoU”) is made and executed on October, 2021 and is effective from October 22, 2021 by and among:

Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences(here referred as “LUVAS” which expression unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof shall include its successors and assigns), located in Hisar, Haryana-125004.

AND

Punjab Engineering College (Deemed to be University) (hereinafter referred to as “PEC” which expression unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject shall mean and include its successors and assigns) located in Sector 12, Chandigarh UT – 160012.


LUVAS and PEC shall hereinafter be collectively referred to as the “Parties” and individually as the “Party”.

2. PREAMBLE

- 2.1. Whereas; LUVAS Hisar has developed as a unique facility for research in the areas of Veterinary and Animal sciences and has eminent faculty.
- 2.2. Whereas; Punjab Engineering College (Deemed to Be University), Chandigarh is a premier institute of international repute imparting engineering and scientific education amongst diverse disciplines and is contributing to the rapidly growing scientific and technological knowledge and professional excellence in Science and Technology by undertaking industrial and applied research and consultancy.
- 2.3. Whereas; LUVAS Hisar and Punjab Engineering College (Deemed to Be University), Chandigarh agree to extend mutual co-operation on terms and conditions hereinafter contained.

3. OBJECTIVE

The general objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between **LUVAS, Hisar and PEC Chandigarh** is to stimulate and facilitate the research facilities and development of collaborative and mutually beneficial programs which serve to enhance the intellectual and research culture on both campuses, and contribute to increase scientific cooperation.



4. SCOPE OF ACTIVITIES:

4.1. This MoU broadly covers the following scope of activities:

- 4.1.1. Research and development of technology in the priority areas mutually established by both Parties;
- 4.1.2. Visits by, and exchanges of, students, scientists and technical experts, as well as public-sector, private-sector or academic specialists, including students and graduates, in the priority areas;
- 4.1.3. Joint organization of seminars, conferences, congresses, workshops and symposiums;
- 4.1.4. Creation of scientific and researcher training networks;
- 4.1.5. Dissemination of results and exchange of experience with respect to the Purpose;
- 4.1.6. Practical training of PEC students at laboratories and research Centre of LUVAS;
- 4.1.7. Guidance of students and researchers for projects, thesis or dissertations under the mutually agreed fields and other areas of interest on mutually agreeable terms;
- 4.1.8. LUVAS may seek assistance or guidance of PEC faculty member/s, for the purpose of design vetting, introduction of technology, improvement of technology, conceptual research, amongst other as remains within the ambit of study of PEC; or mutually agreed terms and conditions on case to case basis;
- 4.1.9. The students will be allowed to utilize the scientific material and physical facilities of each other university with the approval of the Head of the concerned department and it will not hinder the normal working/functioning of the university.
- 4.1.10. If the outcome of a project relates to product development, process technology and design or any other matter which involves matter of proprietary secrecy, the same will not be allowed for publication/printing in any form such as Electronically/verbal, etc. If the outcome of a project results into an intellectual property, for which rights can be secured or credit may be taken, it will be decided on a case to case basis. Similarly, sharing of expenditure in securing such rights and income accrued through royalty etc. by the parties under the law will be decided on a case to case basis after mutual consultation.
- 4.1.11. In any of the activities mentioned above, wherever financial aspects are involved, amount, payment conditions, etc. would be spelt out clearly before starting the activity.

5. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 5.1. Intellectual property, research publications and benefits arising out of commercialization of technologies generated out of co-operation under this agreement shall be jointly owned by LUVAS, Hisar and Punjab Engineering College (Deemed to Be University), Chandigarh or as per guidelines of the funding agency on mutually agreeable terms.



6. TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT

6.1. The MOU shall be effective from the date of its signing by both the parties and shall remain in operation until either Party serves notice to the other for its intention to terminate it. In such events, the MOU shall stand terminated at the end of one calendar month from the date of issue of such notice. In case both the Parties agree to terminate the MOU, the on-going thesis or research work shall be allowed to be completed.

7. AMENDMENTS TO THE AGREEMENT

7.1. The Parties to this MOU may, by mutual consent, add, modify, amend or delete any word, phrase, sentence or article in this MOU at any time during the operation of MOU.



8. SEAL OF PARTIES


