- Post Graduate Diploma in Public Health Management (PGDPHM), (supported under National Health Mission (NHM), Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India)

Veterinary Science Graduates are eligible for the above mentioned health programs and have the potential in contributing towards the well-being of populations through work in public health. The emerging job market in the field of public health is evident from more than 95 percent placements of IIPHs graduates during previous academic year, 2018-19. Over the years, the employers have given a very positive feedback about our students, about their knowledge and skills in public health, commitment towards work and innovative ideas.
