About the Convocation-cum-Scientific Convention

By addressing environmental impacts, improving animal health and welfare, adapting to market pressures, and navigating regulatory challenges, they can create resilient and sustainable business models. Prioritizing innovation, ethical practices, and consumer engagement will be key to their success.

About the National Academy of Veterinary Sciences (NAVS)

The National Academy of Veterinary Sciences (India) is an apex premier agency for the development of Veterinary Sciences in India that was established on lines similar to the National Academy of Medical Sciences by eminent visionary Veterinarians to promote and consolidate the scientific views on policy matters related to Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry and to strive for advancement of livestock sector in national economy through promotion of animal welfare. It has been registered by the Registrar of Societies, Delhi vide Registration Certificate No. S-2/4471 of 1993 dated 7th July, 1993 and has emerged as the largest think-tank of all branches of the profession for research & development departments of the country engaged in Animal Husbandry & Veterinary sectors. The Academy was established to promote the interests of Veterinarians in the country and was launched with Dr. Chinta Mani Singh, regarded as the doyen of Veterinary Services in India, as its Founder President. The academy was formally inaugurated by Hon'ble Minister of State for Animal Husbandry and Dairying (Independent Charge) Government of India, Dr. Raghuvansh Prasad Singh on 18th December, 1996 in Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi, and the Scrolls of Fellowship to the duly elected National Fellows/Members during 1994-95, were presented to them by the Hon'ble Minister at the Investiture ceremony. NAVS established with the aim and objective of promoting knowledge of veterinary sciences, its practical application and to secure coordination between veterinarian and other scientific academic societies, associations, institutions and veterinary/animal husbandry scientific developments and services. The Academy has about 450 members including Fellows, Institutional and Corporate Members and Elected Members. The association is successfully organizing its annual conferences/symposia and convocations for awarding fellowships recognizing life time achievement of its members.

About the Host University - LUVAS

Lala Lajpat Rai University of Veterinary and Animal Sciences (LUVAS), Hisar was established by the Government of Haryana on 1st December, 2010 in pursuance of the Haryana Act No. 7 of 2010 notified on 7th April, 2010. The university has its own new campus of 1124 acre area. The College of Veterinary Sciences is one of the oldest Veterinary Colleges in Northern India. From Lyallpur (currently in Pakistan), the Campus at Hisar was shifted consequent to partition of India. The College has 18 departments with well qualified faculty and modern laboratory infrastructure suitable for practical training of Veterinary Professionals. Apart from College of Veterinary Sciences, University has one College of Dairy Science & Technology to cater the needs of the dairy farmers, students and other stake holders. University has Institute of Para Veterinary Sciences (IPVS) that is an expansion of VLD Diploma section of the University and has been established in February, 2014 with the purpose of producing Para-Veterinarians to assist the Registered Veterinary Practitioners. Presently, there is one constituent college and 16 affiliated Colleges/Institutes under its control.

Venue and Location

Hisar is well connected through buses from neighbouring states as well as ISBT, Kashmiri Gate, Delhi (24x7). Trains for Hisar could be taken from Delhi: 12555/ Gorakhdham SF Express (Departure New Delhi, 05.30 A.M.); 14731/ Kisan Express (Departure Old Delhi, 2.00 P.M.) and 14085/ Haryana Express (Departure New Delhi, 05.55 P.M.).









Weather and Accommodation

Weather is cold during November month. The minimum and maximum temperature will range from 10°C to 15°C. Accordingly, it is advised to keep suitable cold month clothes for comfortable stay during the convocation-cum-scientific convention. Efforts will be made to accommodate delegates in CCSHAU Faculty House (first come first serve basis)/Farmers Hostel (for student delegates), Guest House of GJUS&T /other ICAR Institute(s) situated in Hisar and private hotels. Tariff of hotels will be around Rs. 2000-6000/day. Persons desirous of hotel accommodation are requested to book hotel room online. Local transportation will be provided to the participants from bus stand/railway station, Hisar to convocation-cum-scientific convention venue.
